

CM Europe - Ships Zero Waste System to Niramax – UK

CM has just completed a Zero Waste Tire Recycling System for Niramax, a two location landfill and solid waste RDF processor located in Hartlepool in the UK.

Featured here is the CM4R Liberator with a clean wire screening system and two steel removal magnet stations insuring the cleanest steel reclaim in the industry today with less than 3% contaminants by weight.

This system also produces a variety of +99% wire free crumb rubber feedstock that can be sold for mulch, playground and other value added recycled rubber products.

Since 2007, Niramax has been owned and operated by brothers Nick and Neal Elliott and run by a staff of 100. Niramax is one of the largest and most established “closed loop” service providers handling up to 6,000 tons per week, providing cost effective waste management solutions for the northeast region of the UK.

This is CM’s third Zero Waste installation in Europe this year.
